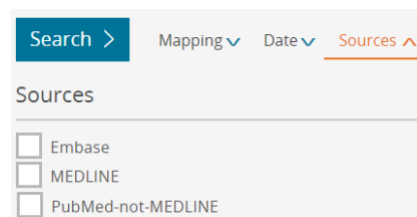
As part of our ongoing commitment to enabling current and comprehensive biomedical research and providing high-quality user experiences, we've made some changes to Embase.

Keeping up-to-date with MEDLINE® and PubMed®

To ensure all searches remain as current and comprehensive as possible, MEDLINE records will be added to Embase sooner than previously possible. We are achieving this by adding the following to Embase when they become available:

- Articles in Process, which have undergone a citation-level review but are not yet indexed with MeSH headings; some may be determined out-of-scope
- Articles in Data Review, which have undergone review at the journal issue level; some may become Articles in Process after their quality review; some may be determined out-of-scope
- PubMed-not-MEDLINE content, which means MEDLINE journal articles that have not been assigned MeSH headings because they are not in scope for MEDLINE

New search limits and syntax limits make it easy to limit the search to particular MEDLINE or PubMed article types. Within "Sources", users can set which records they wish to retrieve:

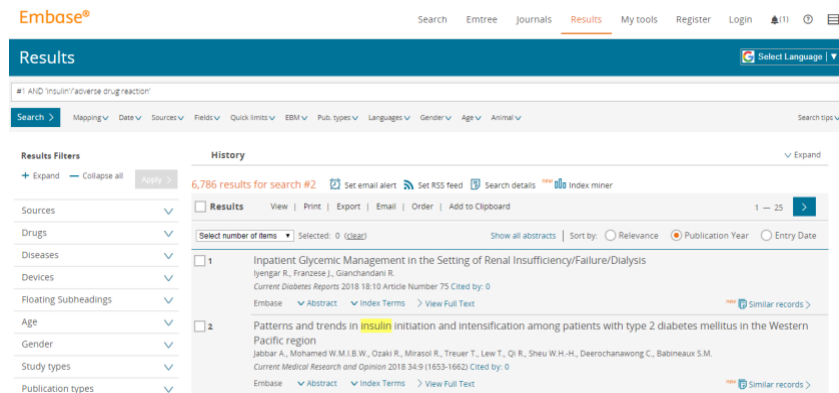


Limits can also be added directly within the syntax for the search.

- **[medline]/lim AND [in process]/lim** retrieves all MEDLINE records but excludes PubMed-not-MEDLINE records
- **[pubmed-not-medline]/lim** retrieves PubMed-not-MEDLINE records

The Record Details page

We're modernizing the Embase user experience with the new Record Details page, which offers several new, interactive features.

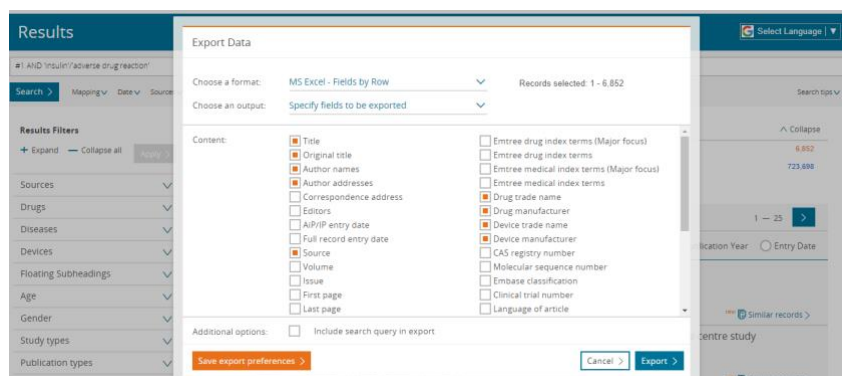


Improvements include:

- Clearer page navigation
- Clearer separation of drug, disease and device fields
- Inclusion of author information
- Sticky action buttons ribbon
- Easy-to-use function buttons
- Mouse-over descriptions of feature actions

Customizable export functionality

By remembering user settings, Embase streamlines the export of content. Registered users can now save export custom field selections so that they don't have to make the same selection every time they use the export features. Non-registered users are prompted with a registration screen if they try to save their export selection. Preferences are available under "My tools" and can be changed when needed.



Updated API security

Embase is increasing the level of security for application programming interface (API) users. End users of the API have been notified of these additional security measures.

Upon authentication, an additional token is generated and provided to Embase HTTP clients. This token, named `org.apache.catalina.filters.CSRF_NONCE`, must be included in subsequent requests to authenticate and consume content via the API.

Users who only access Embase through their browser will not be affected.
