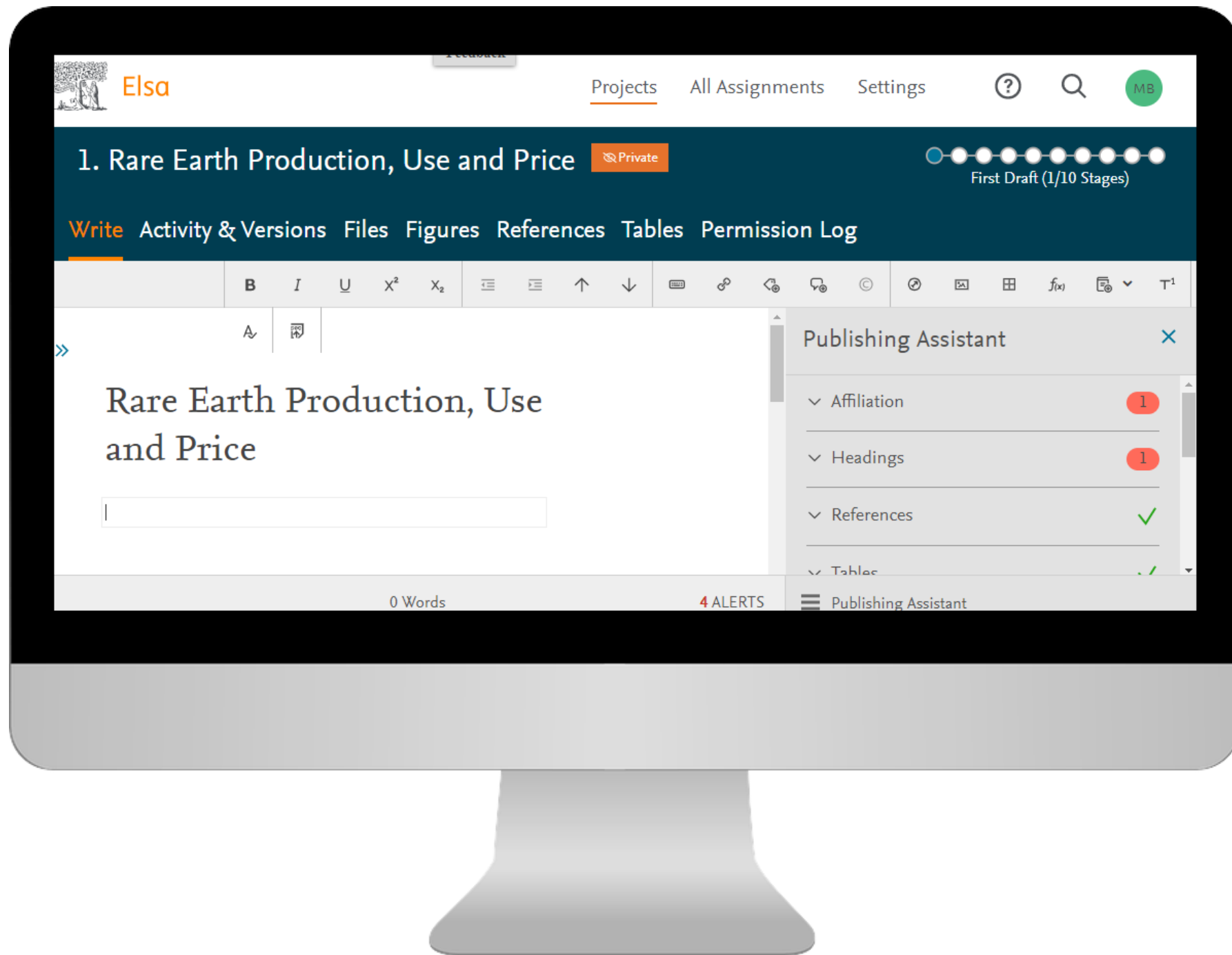

Why Elsa?

Elsa is an authoring platform. Write and integrate key features (figures, tables, equations, etc.) to your project directly within Elsa.

Elsa's **Publishing Assistant** informs you about missing items and tagging to improve your content's discoverability.

Elsa makes communication and monitoring your progress simple. Track your project through easy-to-follow workflow stages and version comparisons.


Log in

All you need is Google Chrome and internet!



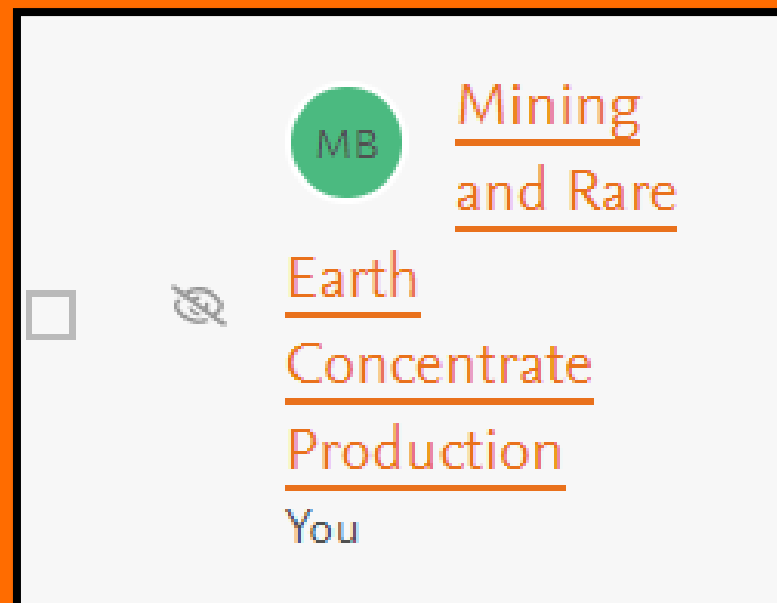

Click the name of the chapter(s) you have been assigned to work on.

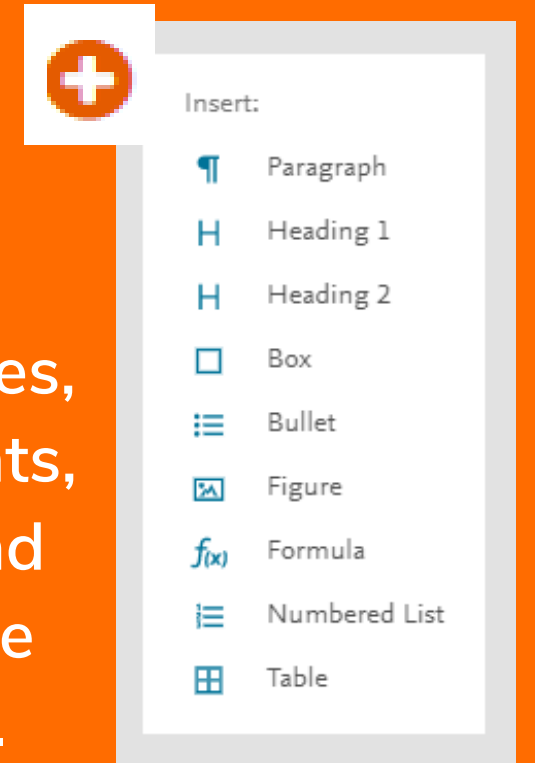

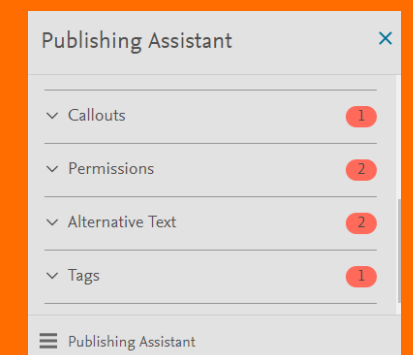
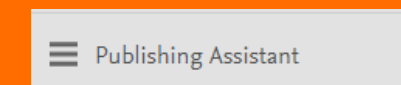
Start writing

Create content using the plus sign.

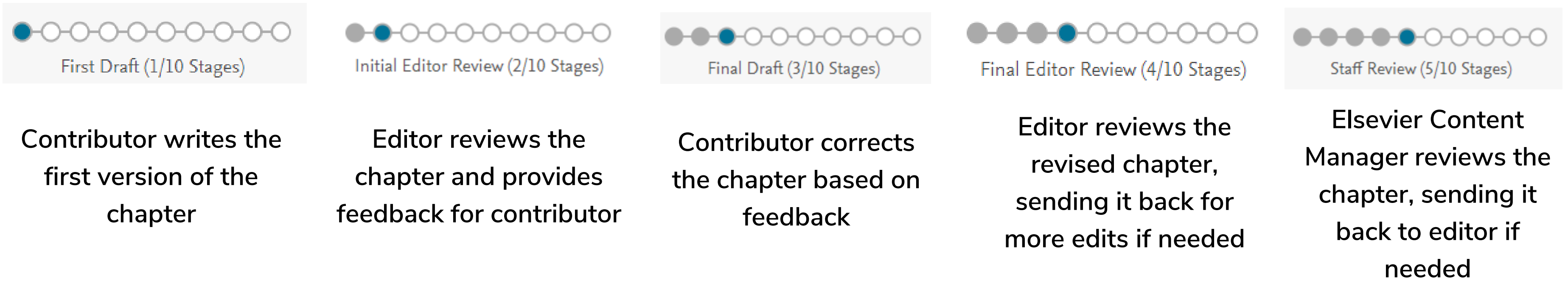
Insert footnotes, tags, comments, references, and more using the bar at the top.
